Treasury Report: \$2,444.89 -\$97 for out of pocket expenses.

Battery Chargers Report: Two new Schumacher SC-1200A-CA chargers were purchased and given to Andy and Gary to try out. These chargers are a newer generation that will not overcharge the 6 volt Optima AGM (Absorbent Glass Mat) type battery that avoids the overheating seen with manual mode chargers. DO NOT charge these type batteries over 10 Amperes! Should these chargers prove good, we will purchase them for all winch setups.

Denise Johns and I are meeting with the VC Star and the Acorn this week to go over the current status of the Sapwi Trails project. We will be giving them your names and email addresses if they want to get in direct contact with you as a user group.

As far as the project goes, we are in the final review of the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and should have it out for public review in about two weeks, thus an agenda item for an October (2nd or 16nd) Board meeting. We will keep you updated as we go along but your presence at that meeting is strongly encouraged.

If all goes well, upon adoption of the MND and the project, volunteer activities for construction under CRPD supervision and coordination may commence immediately; design development for activities that require and outside contractor will commence also, but construction would still be about a year away.

Other issues, such as funding of construction activities and user group agreements, would still be necessary to finalize and detail.

We will reach out to all of you after the October Board meeting and, depending on the results of that meeting, discuss options and avenues to move as quickly as possible with your user group.

Thanks for your patience, the light and the end of the tunnel is getting brighter (and no, I don't think it is a train).
