February's Meeting Has Been Moved!


Things have started to get a bit crowded at the Greenhouse so this month we're going to try out the Clubhouse at Myles's residence.

News from January's CD.....

Well, after an overall wet week, it was nice to dry out a bit for January's contest, the first for 2001. And true to form, it started out with some surprises. Sunday dawned crisp with a thin vale of high clouds. Winds were non-existent at the time of the pilot meeting. We called for a 3, 6, and 8 min. round - 900, 100 scoring. It looked like the day was setting up just right. The winches were set up to the west, and we were expecting the normal onshore breeze to develop with perhaps some cumulus clouds blooming as the morning warmed up. Well, the first flight was going just dandy until one freshly rebuilt winch motor literally went up in smoke! That set the stage for what turned out to be a really interesting contest. Right at about the start of the second round, Murphy stepped in, and the wind decides to make a 180 shift and blow offshore! That changed the complexion of

the whole event. Now it became down-wind launches followed by a mad scramble to work the surrounding topography for lift. This worked very well for some flyers, but not for others who got caught a bit off guard. There were 4 or 5 off-field landings, and unfortunately one into the trees (God I hate that sound!). The wind came in the form of rolling gusts, some of which made landing control or penetration difficult. There were some shorttimes and low landing points amongst the 10 open and 4 sport entries on the board. Ironically, sometime after the last round was done, the winds seemed to subside for some really nice flying put on by BJ Weisman and Mike Reagan. A side note: It is really nice to have visitors coming to see our contests. Lots of questions, interest, and perhaps some return customers!



- 1. Consecutive flights starting with 10 sec, 15, 20, 25, etc, 10 min window.
- 2. Best 5 flights, 2 minute max, 6 tosses, 10 min window.
- 3. Best 4 flights, with a max of 1, 2, 3, and 4 min each, 10 min window.
- 4. Best use of time table, allowing 15, 30, 45 and 60 second flights.
- 5. Best time, 3 flight minimum, 15 second minimum, no max time, with last flight being longer than previous flight to count, 10 minute window.

First flight scheduled for 9:00am, and pilot meeting at 8:45. Entry fee only \$8.00, with awards 1st through 3rd in Sportsman and Expert. Come join us for an Inland Empire tradition!
