April's contest tasks were based on the wing span of the glider. The longer the wing span, the longer the flight times All flights were worth 950/50 points. Landings were scored on a 25 foot tape. The handicap for Novice and Beginner pilots were bonus points equal to their wingspan. All rounds had to be flown in the order shown.

Most people were able to make their times during the first two rounds. Around 10:30 - 11:00 some strong sink blew through. Even the best had some difficult times.

All in all, most had a good time. Based on the results, we have a new "SPORT" flyer - Kyle Carmona. Congratulations Kyle, you have proved again that your are competitive with the other "old " guys.

I received suggestions from various contestants after the contest. They were to start enforcing some old TOSS contest rules. So starting in May, pilots arriving after 9:30 will not be permitted to participated in the contest no will they be able to fly until the last contestant has flown their last flight.
