**Steve signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)** with CRPD for SAPWI Park. This is a part of the overall ratification of the park project that took place this last week. The new flying site is now official! We are now set to move forward with the CRPD folks regarding the construction of our site. Steve read a memo from Tom Hare in regards to what the next steps will be. One question, what do we want to present to the parks folks in regards to access? We

want the public to be allowed to access the flying site so they can observe what we do, while at the same time, who will be the keeper of the access to our area? We are in our own, special permit area as opposed to what the other stake holders have as access. We have a special use permit for our area, but at the same time, we don't want to be too restrictive on who can come onto the flight site. We still have to hash out the details of access with the CRPD folks, and who has control over the flight area.

**There were discussions about a plan for TOSS exhibiting at various community venues** to get positive exposure for the club. These include Conejo Valley Days, Conejo Art Walk, Camarillo Air Show, Touch A Truck, etc..

**December 11 is the SC2, Toys for Tots contest at the Field of Dreams.** TOSS has donated \$100 for Mike Regan to shop for toys to be donated in TOSS' name. See Mike Reagan about bringing additional toys to the contest.
