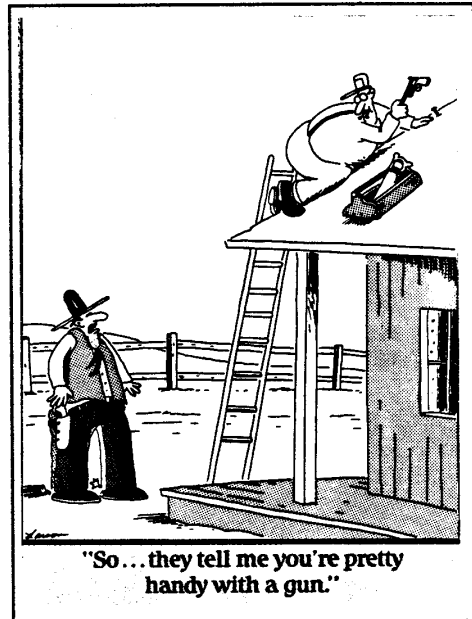
You will also find a 1991 membership enrollment form, if I don't have it in my hot little

hand by February 1st. I won't send you a Newsletter. You won't be a member anymore. As I said last year, that might be a blessing in disguise.

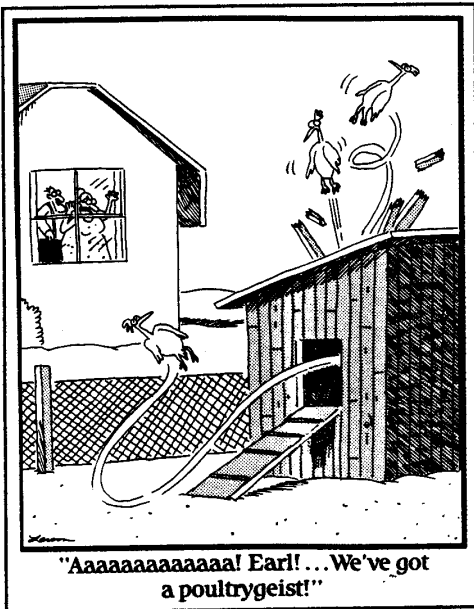
