OCTOBER MEETING NOTES

OLD BUSINESS:

1) More discussions were held on approval of all non-standard contest formats.

NEW BUSINESS:

1) The majority of the meeting was spent on activities and assignments for the October SCSC contest to be held at Redwood School.

2) The annual Delta Cub Workshop at Paramount Ranch is to be held on November 18th. We need volunteers to assist in the supervising construction and trimming of the rubber band powered planes. Volunteers should arrive at approximately 8:45 AM.

3) Edgar Weisman raised the question if TOSS would like to hold a Cross-Country Contest in 1996. The proposed standard course would be 10 miles long (5 miles out and 5 miles back). It was also suggested that in order to attract more participants, shortened courses would be made available and marked for LSF III, IV and V skill level qualifications. Start / End and turn-around judges would be manned by TOSS members. The idea was approved with Art McNamee to take charge to obtain the field at TAFT sometime in the April / May time frame. It would be in place of our normal monthly contest. Most likely, the contest would be a one day event pending upon responses from TOSS and other clubs.

Thousand Oaks Soaring Society October SC2 Contest

T.O.S.S.'s biggest SC2 ever with 64 contestants, over a dozen came from San Diego (T.P.G.).

The tasks turned out to be the perfect call as the overcast skies made the 24 minute Add-Em-Up very challenging indeed. Putting some of the hottest fliers well down in the standings.

Sandbagging was the order of the day with empty skies for long periods of time, then long lines at the winches when any lift showed or the round deadline approached. This made for some large gaggles with at least one midair in which Mike Ratner was knocked into a flat spin. Only the application of full flaps pulled it out. The other plane looked like minor damage but folded on the next winch launch destroying a brand new sailplane.

Some of the TPG group came up on Saturday and practiced which really helped.

Pat Dionisio won Expert with an almost perfect score of 2998 (3 perfect landings, 1 second over time).

A tie for second place between Richard Burns and Joe Rodriguez was forfeited when we found Rich had already gone home. Brendan Lugo and Paul Trist tied for third place Expert. So a flyoff using a hi-start was called with Brendan besting by a few seconds. (There turned out to be a scoring error with Trist actually being third by 2 points).

Thomas Akers took first in Sportsman by getting all his time but only one landing. This moves him up to Expert class.

The large turnout made it hard for our small club to run but as it turned out we had just enough people. When one person went to fly, it was REALLY noticed. A HUGE thanks to all the TOSS guys who helped keep things going.

All in all, it was a good contest and certainly much better than last years blow out. Now we'll be known as the field with no lift!

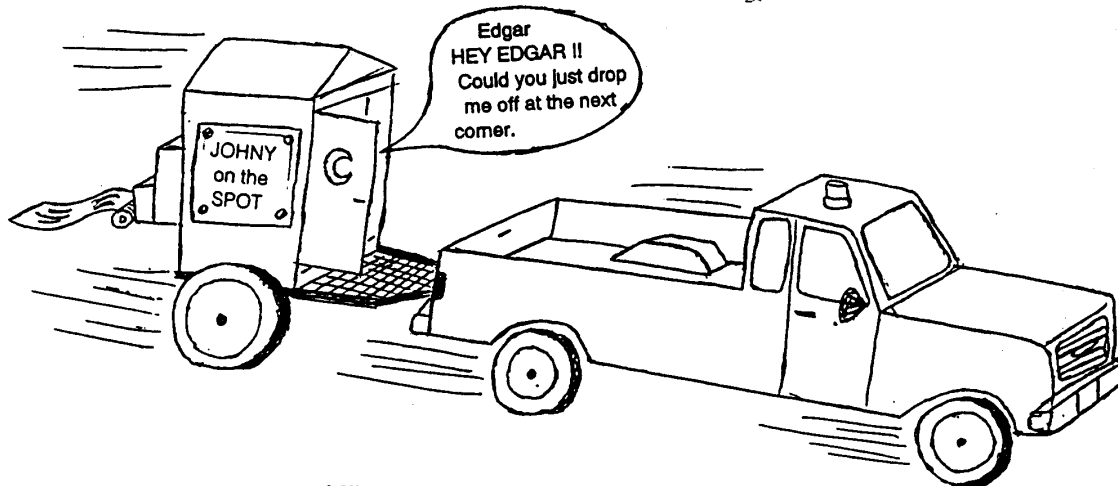

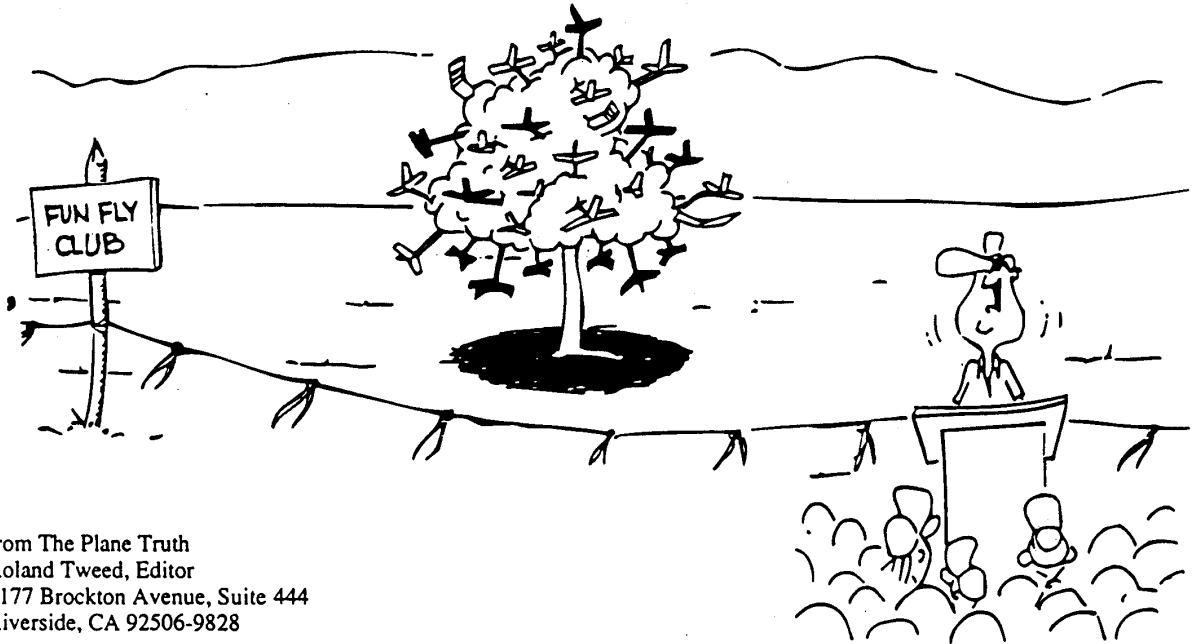
