There are tasks that are performed without any officially designated person. Winches get maintained, contests get scored, trophies purchased, contest fliers designed, printed and mailed, all without anyone formally being involved. In practise - and, we suspect, like most clubs - its the same faces that perform all of these functions. One or two new ones, even to just help out a bit, are always welcome.

And, this year we've got the program with the students to organize. Now that's starting to look like real work.....





