We had a FOSS attendance of no less than 13 members this year - an OUTSTANDING show of support for the TOSS showing. Those who flew included Craig Borstelman, Gary Filice, Art and Don McNamee, Don Northern, Lex Meirop, Jim Pendergrass, Mike Reagan, Mike Stern, Bob Swet, Terry Koplan, Bill Nibley, Keith Millet. With the ounds being 3, 6, 7, and 8 min. the first day, this did not seem to be so bad. But, ry flying for your eight minute at 5:05 in the evening! Many of the top pilots were nung out to dry in that last round of the first day! That round took exceptional flying kills, just to stay up in very soft air that was getting softer by the minute! And yes, hey did it again with the split bull's eye as last year. Many were "bitten by the bite" on the back side of the Bull's eye and came up empty score wise. HSS - (SC)² UPDATE

Oct. 22, 2003

Wow, lots of entries already received, channels are filling up so PLEASE get signed up ASAP so you won't miss out. When you email me don't forget to say what class you are flying in. I don't know everyone's SC2 class by heart.

It looks like we will run up to 11 pilots per slot to keep the number of slots to a minimum. The landing area has been watered and is showing a little green already; it's not grass but in either case it will be softer than usual.

The time change is contest day so if you don't set your clocks you will be 1 hour early. Great! We can use the help!! This will help us get started on time because the coastal fog should be gone by 9:30 first flight. (*Forecast suggests Santa Anas.....Ed.*)

Remember, all pilots need to sign up by 9:00. Please don't be late. Entries will close and no one will be added to the matrix if they are late. No one. Not even you.

The HLG contest scheduled for after the SC2 is canceled. Sorry but there will not be enough time. Tell your friends please.

To keep the contest moving there is a strong chance that we will launch the next slot 8 minutes into the previous slot. If we do this we could save 36 minutes per round. We need the extra time. This should let enough separation so we won't crowd the landing zones. We will only launch if the previous group is downwind clear of the launch area. After a few minutes everyone is usually downwind a fair amount anyway.


